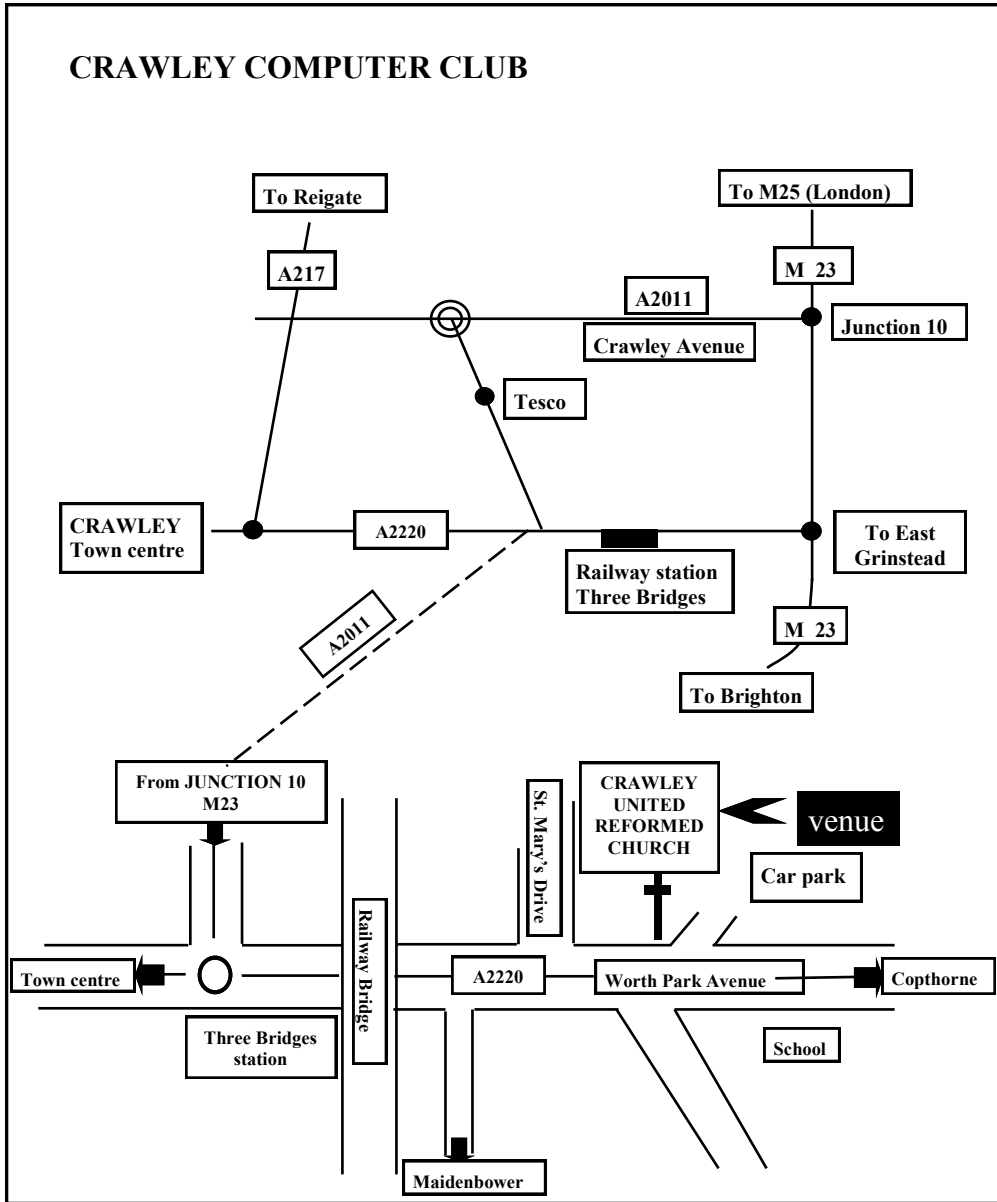

CHANGES IN THE CONSTITUTION

Changes in the Club Constitution may only be made by a two-thirds majority vote of members attending the Annual General Meeting of the Club.

Any member wishing to propose an amendment to the constitution must submit the proposal, in writing, to the Secretary at least two weeks before the Annual General Meeting.

CLOSURE OF THE CLUB

An Extraordinary General Meeting of the Club shall be called for the purpose of determining the future of the Club, and providing that at least 75% of those attending the meeting agree the Club may be wound up. The final outcome will be decided by the whole membership in a postal ballot with the closing date stated on the ballot paper.

The scrutineers for the postal ballot will be appointed at a Extraordinary General Meeting of the Club. All members must be notified in writing of the result of the ballot.

After the outstanding accounts and expenses have been settled, the balance of any money and the remaining assets of the Club shall be donated to a charity to be determined by those present at the Extraordinary General Meeting.

CONSTITUTION

The Club shall be known as the “Crawley Computer Club” hereinafter named as “the Club”.

OBJECTS

MEMBERSHIP

Membership of the Club shall be open to all users of computers who have paid the annual membership fee that shall be decided at the Annual General Meeting of the Club. The Club financial year shall commence on the first day of September.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Annual General Meeting of the Club shall be held on the first Thursday in September. Notice of the AGM MUST be given in the newsletter at least one month before the date of the meeting. 30% of the full (non-postal) membership shall constitute a quorum for that meeting.
